## SF 2350: Updated Retail Alcohol Licenses

Retail Alcohol License Type	Description/Privilege
<b>Class “B” Retail Alcohol License</b>	For grocery, liquor, and convenience stores, etc. Sale of beer and wine for off-premise consumption in original unopened containers. No sales by the drink. Includes Sunday Sales. Also allows wholesale to Class C, Special Class C, Class D, and Class F Alcohol Retail Licensees.
<b>Special Class “B” Retail Alcohol License</b>	For grocery, liquor, and convenience stores, etc. Sale of Iowa native wine for off-premises consumption in original unopened container. No sales by the drink. Includes Sunday Sales.
<b>Class “C” Retail Alcohol License</b>	For taverns, bars, restaurants, etc. Sale of liquor, beer, wine for on-premises consumption. Allows to-go cocktails and carry-out of unopened containers. Includes Sunday Sales.
<b>Special Class “C” Retail Alcohol License</b>	For taverns, bars, restaurants, etc. Sale of beer and wine for on-premises consumption. Allows to-go cocktails and carry-out of unopened containers. Includes Sunday Sales.
<b>Class “D” Retail Alcohol License</b>	For trains, airplanes, and watercraft. Sale of liquor, beer, and wine for on-premises consumption only. No carry-out sales. Includes Sunday Sales.
<b>Class “E” Retail Alcohol License</b>	For grocery, liquor, and convenience stores, etc. Sale of liquor, beer, and wine for off-premise consumption in original unopened containers. No sales by the drink. Includes Sunday Sales. Also allows wholesale to Class C, Special Class C, Class D, and Class F Alcohol Retail Licensees.
<b>Class “F” Retail Alcohol License</b>	For non-profit clubs (members and guests only). Sale of liquor, beer, & wine for on-premises only. No to-go cocktails or carry-out sales. Includes Sunday Sales.
<b>Charity Beer, Spirits, and Wine Special Event License</b>	For non-profit entities. Sale of liquor, beer, & wine during a charity special event.

### Examples

**Current Regulation:** To operate a convenience store selling liquor, beer, & wine, you need to have the following licenses:

- Class E Liquor License
- Class C Beer Permit
- Class B Wine Permit

**New Regulation:** To operate a convenience store in selling liquor, beer & wine, you need to have the following license:

- Class “E” Retail Alcohol License

**Current Regulation:** To operate a restaurant or bar selling liquor, beer, & wine, you need to have the following license:

- Class C Liquor License

**New Regulation:** To operate a restaurant or bar selling liquor, beer, & wine, you need to have the following license:

- Class “C” Retail Alcohol License (No Change)
